Comments Brock Imperial F1 forms a very attractive pack. It has a long shelf life, and is a good shipper. This variety produces spears 5-7 days earlier than UC 157. When grown from seed, first cutting can start in the second year. It is extremely heat tolerant during fern growth. Recommended for California type climates.
