

Asparagus Brock Imperial F1

- Description:** This variety has great uniformity and size. The tips are large, tight, and smooth. Coloration is dark green. This variety reinitiates spears after cutting very quickly. It is very productive. Its performance is superior to IDA LEA and UC 157 F1.
- Maturity:** Early
- Disease Tolerance:** Fusarium rust, Cercospora Foliar
- Comments** Brock Imperial F1 forms a very attractive pack. It has a long shelf life, and is a good shipper. This variety produces spears 5-7 days earlier than UC 157. When grown from seed, first cutting can start in the second year. It is extremely heat tolerant during fern growth. Recommended for California type climates.



Asparagus Early California F1 Hybrid

Description: Early California F1 is a Clonal hybrid. This variety is cylindrical in shape, with slight, tapering spear tips. The spears are large, very tight in warm conditions, and smooth due to the bud scales being tightly oppressed. Coloration is dark green with a little purple coloration on the bud scales, butt, and tip. This variety is extremely productive.

Maturity: Early

Disease Tolerance: Fusarium Rust, Cercospora Foliar

Comments: Early California F1 spear production can start very early, and can extend through very late in the cutting season. This Cultivar variety is a good shipper, and can out produce previous UC and New Jersey Cultivars.



Asparagus Green Arrow F1 Hybrid
